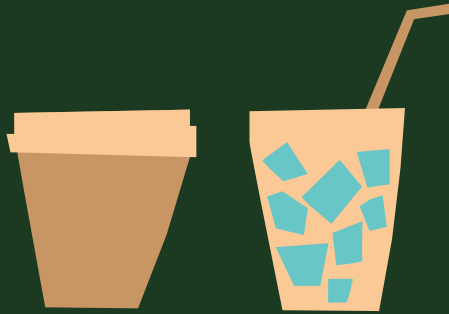


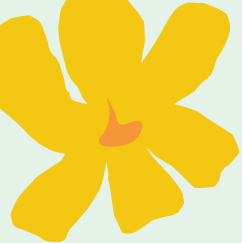

# Reusable Foodware Ordinance

## DINE-IN

- Reusable foodware for dine-in
- Recycling and compost bins for customers
- Foodware accessories upon request



## TAKE-OUT

- Chemical free or BPI certified unlined, wood-based/paper compostable foodware
- \$0.25 single-use hot/cold cup charge
- Foodware accessories upon request



- Marin County confirms that it is safe to fill a customer's reusable container unless the server deems them unsanitary
- Online delivery platforms must offer opt-in options for accessories
- Compostable paper wrappers, sleeves, bags, napkins, straws, trays, liners, and foil are allowed
- If beverages are being delivered, lids, plugs, and sleeves can be automatically included
- The \$0.25 cup charge needs to be identified on receipts, menus, online ordering platforms, and verbally over the phone
