**NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD FOR AND BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEARING
FOR PROPOSED 2021 ANNUAL FUNDING ALLOCATION**

The County of Marin Consolidated Plan for Fiscal Years 2020-24 (Consolidated Plan) is a planning and budgeting report mandated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for entitlement communities. The Plan describes the affordable housing and priority non-housing community development needs of extremely low to moderate-income persons in the County, and sets forth priorities and strategies for meeting these needs. The Consolidated Plan includes an annual Action Plan for each year of the 5-year period. The second-year Action Plan serves as the Fiscal Year 2021 budget for the use of Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funds. The County of Marin is required to amend the Consolidated Plan Action Plan annually to reflect each new program year's budget for the use of CDBG and HOME funds. The County is also required to update the Consolidated Plan with new affordable housing and priority non-housing community needs data as it becomes available, and to address public comments received during the public hearings and the comment period.

The proposed budgets for the use of Fiscal Year 2021 CDBG and HOME Program funds will be presented in the 2021 Annual Action Plan. All activities recommended for funding are consistent with the County's priorities as reported in the Consolidated Plan.

This notice is to inform the public and all relevant parties that a 30-day comment period will open on Sunday, April 4th, 2021. To access the Draft Consolidated Plan visit www.marincounty.org/federalgrants.
