

An important message from the Marin County Elections Department about the  
**Presidential Primary Election - March 5, 2024**

# You get to vote one ballot. Make sure it is the ballot you want!

Each qualified Political Party has their own ballot for the Primary Election. If you are registered with a Party, you will get a ballot with Presidential candidates from that Party.

If you are registered as **No Party Preference** (also known as Independent or Decline to State), you will get a ballot without Presidential candidates **unless** you have already contacted the Elections Department **or** take action. **Ballots start mailing on February 5**

**Look inside to find Vote Center and Drop Box locations!**

**Vote early and avoid lines. You have nearly a month to return your ballot. If you want your vote included in election night results, return your ballot by February 28.**
