OCTOBER 24 IS DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE

Monday, October 24, is the deadline to register to vote in the November 8, 2011 General District Election. To be eligible to register to vote a person must be a US citizen, resident of California, 18 years old by Election Day, not in prison or on parole for the conviction of a felony, and not determined to be mentally incompetent by a judge.

Mail-in voter registration forms are available at post offices, libraries, city clerks' offices, fire stations, and the Department of Motor Vehicles. Voters may also print out and mail a registration form from the Elections website at <u>www.marinvotes.org</u>. Voter registration forms must be postmarked by the October 24th deadline to be valid for the upcoming election.

The Marin County Election Office is open weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for in-person registration. The office is located at the Marin Civic Center, 3501 Civic Center Drive, Room 121, San Rafael, CA 94903.
