EARLY VOTING BEGINS ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 8

San Rafael, California –Marin County voters can begin voting on Monday,
October 8 at the Elections Office at the Marin Civic Center, 3501 Civic Center
Drive, Room 121, San Rafael, M-F from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The office will
also be open for voting on Saturday and Sunday, November 3 and 4 from 9
a.m. to 1 p.m. and on Election Day, November 6, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The Elections Office will mail ballots to nearly 100,000 Marin voters on Tuesday, October 9.

Mail Ballots do not follow voters when they move. Voters should re-register to vote when their addresses change so that they will receive their election mail. Voters can call the Elections Office at 415-473-6456 or visit www.marinvotes.org to check and update voter registration information and to get an application to vote by mail.
